Minutes Parish Council meeting 12th November 2015

Questions and comments from the floor not listed on the agenda: matters raised:

5 members of the Parish present.

- John Townsend asked the Parish Council to investigate his multiple planning applications he has submitted for a barn conversion at Ullenwood Park Farm as these applications have been declined without further action or consultation and his fee refunded by Cotswold District Council.
- David Carlton advised the Parish Council that he has the Parish Council owned strimmer and mower in his garage. (info for the assets register)
- Discussion took place regarding land ownership in the Parish -
- Land between Ham Mead and Coberley Court, Village Green and Seven Springs is al believed to be common land. As the area between Ham Mead is very overgrown David Carlton asked whether the Parish Council would like the Cotswold Voluntary Wardens to clear this area. It was agreed that Dan Powell will draft a letter to the owners of Ham Mead and Coberley Court asking them if they are happy for the Wardens to tidy the area, safeguarding the trees, and before the snowdrop bulbs start to grow again.
- Discussion took place regarding Cotswold District Council's plan for traveller sites. DM briefly outlined the situation with regard to both the current planning application and the emerging Local Plan. The current planning application is an agenda item (see below)
- Broadband Paul Hodgkinson advised that Gigaclear is now working in Coberley
- He also advised that Gloucestershire County Council are facing a 30% cut in their budget over the next 3 years
- A417 missing link -Consultation regarding design etc will happen before 2020 when it is hoped work will commence.
- Grit Bins should be filled on Monday 16th November.
- It was asked whether the Parish Council will ask for additional housing when drafting the Neighbourhood Plan as it is felt by some parishioners that they would like to see more suitable housing in the area. DM explained that the parishioners would be consulted as part of the process.
- Drain outside Oxford Cottages is still blocked and overflows in heavy rain.
- Dr Sale enquired about the development taking place at the Salad Bowl on Leckhampton Hill Road (see response under 'Planning' below.

Dan Powell declared an interest as adjoining land owner to the Traveller Site in Hartley Lane.

- It was agreed to wait for the drafting of the Neighbourhood Plan to input concerns about Barn conversion policy.

There is an unsightly development taking place on The Salad Bowl, opposite Salterley Grange. This includes sheds and fencing. The Chair is already following up with Cotswold District Council.
