14.	<p><b>Council considered outstanding planning matters</b>  22/03134/FUL- Proposed single storey side extension and entrance porch at Cherry Tree Cottage Coberley distributed to Councillors – “no comment”</p> <p>Additional application received – Barn – Clerk to use delegated authority to submit objection based on, contrary to original application permission which stated no additional building to be approved and this application would have negative visual impact and are out of keeping with a Cotswold -stone development</p>
15.	<p><b>Council has invited updates from Highways Manager on the following matters but no updates have been received – Council expressed its concerns that no response has been received</b></p> <p><b>Minor list</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Road markings at Coberley junction – 22/23</li> <li>• Seven Spring junction markings -A436/A435 lane markings to be referred to Road safety team -discussion regarding road width and separation into 2 lanes. Markings on double roundabouts need updating – timescale summer 22</li> <li>• Damaged gate posts at cattle grid, also reported that the gateway is blocked works anticipated during 22/23 and working with PROW team</li> </ul> <p><b>Major list</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ullenwood crossroads -Road Safety Team to look at hotspot accident data in April 22, gulley outside cottages will need repair and will provide opportunity for road markings to be enhanced (example of Foxcote given of possible scheme) - Autumn 22</li> <li>• Barber Wood drain – to be investigated by Highways and history of installation to be confirmed</li> <li>• Question regarding if possibility of reducing speed to 40mph was raised- DT said further information would be sought on data and criteria</li> <li>• PC has sought some designated funding from A417 missing link- no heavy vehicle signs” would need traffic orders: Glos Highways to check if there are any traffic orders already in place</li> <li>• Dead Ash tree tree between Village and Church was waiting for a report but the tree has now been marked</li> <li>• Broken drain/coned area outside Oxford Cottages</li> </ul> <p><b>Other Highway issues discussed included</b>  Drainage investigations- mapping has been done and next stage is new gulleys to be installed.  20mph projects- Glos Highways process/criteria noted  “Beware of Horses” sign east bound is damaged – A436 Air Balloon to Seven Springs  Grit bin top up time schedule – Clerk to check email in the summer?</p>
