Coberley Parish – Major Highways Issues For Parish Council Meeting, 1 February 2023

- 1. Surface water through Coberley village: Problems of surface water drainage, flow of water through village and property flooding. Noted that in a number of cases, the drain locations are on the opposite side of the road to the flow of water. Video demonstrates that the main flow of surface water from the PROW to the north misses these two drains. Site meeting held 18 October (DT, PH, DC, DM + RK) Agreed that: 1. DT to arrange gullies to channel water across road (beside school) into drains. 2. DT to consult PROW for views. 3. Subsequent consultation with landowner as appropriate. DT advised at PC meeting 23 March 2022 work to be done in new financial year DT: funding in place for the installation of two new gullies. Can we have a site meeting on 9/6/22 (midday?) (Meeting confirmed for pm) to agree locations and mark up the site. Done. Drains surveyed 22 Sept. ACTION: GCC to advise date for gully installation please.
- 2. A436 Cowley/Ullenwood crossroads. Timescale for implementation of safety measures please. Speed limit reduction to 40mph urged. Note: unable to locate the new marker posts referred to at crossroads. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 22 that Road Safety Team hotspot review would cover this area in April 2022. Repair of gully by Oxford Cottages will provide opportunity for road markings to be enhanced. Work due Autumn 2022, but isolated defects (pothole at Coberley Road junction and Barber Wood drainage grid) sooner. Speed limit further information would be sought on data and criteria.
 - DT: funding in place to enhance SLOW markings on road with red panels. I have been advised by our road marking operative that they cannot install red paint in-between the centre lines to highlight the junction. We will remark all the white lines on approach to and through the junction. We are going to join this work up with patching and drainage work Oxford Cottages, this work has to be planned and measured so I do not have a date for this yet. Awaiting call from the road safety team to discuss the County Accident Hot Spot list to see if this site features and what opportunities this may present for wider works.
 - Happy to look at dragon's teeth marking at the panels closest to the cross roads. ACTION: GCC Update please. Note also Point 4 below.
- Ongoing consultation with GCC Highways and County Councillor on options to reduce speeds along the Coberley Road from A436 to A435 junctions, in particular through the village. DT advised PC meeting 23 March of GCC policy review on 20mph speed limits. Public consultation due May/Summer 2022.
 - DT: Road Safety has been put back to officers by Full Council for further work, I do not know when this will now be adopted. ACTION: GCC Update on status please.
- 4. Ongoing consultation with National Highways and County Councillor regarding A417 Missing Link project and implications for Coberley Parish, including any possible Designated Funding. Statement of Common Ground agreed between Coberley PC and National Highways

May 2022. DCO granted 17 Nov 2022. PC to continue discussion with National Highways and with GCC/County Councillor as appropriate. Meeting held with GCC to discuss possibility of joint application for National Highways Designated Funding to improve safety on A436 at Ullenwood/Cowley crossroads. 21 Oct: GCC to review Expression of Interest form and comment re cost of work to research and complete form. ACTION: GCC to respond ref next step in joint application for funding.

- Diverted Restricted Byway at Dowmans Development. Current diversion is unsuitable. Unfit for horses. Steep, muddy incline for walkers. This should be restored to original route promptly now that driveway to development is reopened. ACTION: GCC to restore original restricted byway route.
- 6. Leckhampton Hill Road. There are numerous substantial potholes along the stretch between the junction with A436 and the Salterley Grange entrance, on both carriageways and the surface is generally very poor. Please arrange urgent inspection and necessary repairs. ACTION: GCC

Coberley Parish – Minor Highways Issues For Parish Council Meeting 1 February 2023

- 1. Damaged signpost at junction to Upper Coberley, directly opposite Cowley junction, on A435. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 work to be carried out in new financial year.
 - DT: works order issued awaiting installation date from Ringway. ACTION: GCC Update please
- 2. Warning signage on A435 stretch between Cowley and Coberley turnings. Damaged sign replaced, but matching set of signs to north of crossing has one sign which has completely faded and is totally illegible (presume horse-rider sign). DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 work to be carried out in new financial year.
 - DT: works order issued awaiting installation date from Ringway. Slacks barn directional sign ticket raised, works needs three-way lights to deliver. ACTION: GCC Update please.
- 3. Dead ash tree on verge on Coberley Road beside Ham Mead. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 tree not on priority list but waiting inspection. DT: no inspection feedback to date. ACTION: GCC Update please
- **4.** Junction of road from Close Farm and the Cowley Road with main Coberley Road review give way markings please. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 work to be carried out in new financial year.
 - DT; works ticket raised for give way markings to be remarked. With our lining contractor to deliver. ACTION: GCC Update please
- **5.** A436/435 roundabout at Seven Springs. Directional road markings to be assessed and repainted. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 to be referred to Road Safety Team, consider road width and separation into 2 lanes. Summer 2022.

DT: the feedback from our road safety team was to have the markings changed to have the left lane as A436 (left turn arrow) and the right lane as A436 & A417 (straight on arrow). These marking would need to be supported by advance signage. We do then need to do checks on site to establish where the signing can go (and get

a design for the sign), measure road widths to see how far back we can take the two lanes

The new markings are proposed for the southbound approach to the northern roundabout. I think it might be worth adding the wording 'A435' to lane with the straight on arrow, too. These markings will be supported by the signing too and I would be inclined to add E (east) and W (west) to the A436 text on the sign for each lane to denote which way to go. I don't think there is space on the road to add this to the text on the road, but if we do have space then I will get it done.

I am minded to get all the road markings redone at both roundabouts, but this would not see any changes, just remarking what is there. ACTION: GCC Update please.

- 6. Damaged gate post Gated road and cattle grid, Coberley Road adjacent to Dowmans Barns. GCC Highways reports that site checked and whilst the gate post is damaged, it is safe and operational. Will be added to the list of minor works to deliver in the new financial year. However, the PC has reports that the gate does not latch properly (in order to be stock proof must be held closed with a rope or chain); Considered that it would be very difficult to open or close from horseback, hence not fit for purpose. Suggested that both gate and post should be replaced as a matter of urgency. DT advised PC meeting 23 March 2022 work to be carried out in new financial year.
 DT: we will repair the gate with our Community Maintenance gang. Date to be supplied, but it will be done in the next month 6 weeks. ACTION: GCC update please.
- 7. Leckhampton Hill Road. Pavement from Ullenwood Court for quarter mile towards A436 junction impassable for wheelchair users due to overhanging vegetation and mud deposits (some work done). Poor road surface requires attention.
 - DT: has arranged for a safety inspection of this footway and vegetation. We did carry out some clearing and footway repairs here by the community maintenance gang in the previous financial year. ACTION: GCC update please.
- 8. Complaint re heavy vehicles using Coberley Road and request from public for signage. Noted that there is a 7.5 ton restriction sign at junction with A436 and 'Unsuitable for heavy vehicle' sign at A435 junction. ACTION: GCC. Please standardise with correct signage.
- 9. Hartley Lane. Review of weight/size restriction signage required. Recent incident with large curtain-sided lorry. 7.5T sign at A435 end should be repositioned. No signage at Leckhampton Hill end. (only signage is at either end of Leckhampton Hill Road). ACTION: GCC to review please. Items 8 & 9: I have asked the TRO team for a copy of the 7.5T weight limit Order so that we can check the extents and exactly what roads are covered. We will then audit the existing signage and make sure they are consistent and correct. We'll double check with the parish council before making any changes. I suspect that the village is included in the Lorry Management Zone and so the terminals for the Traffic Order are beyond the limit of the village, but I will confirm this when I have checked the Traffic Orders. ACTION: GCC update please.
- 10. Farm Vehicle Warning Sign, A435 opposite side of road to Slacks
 Barn/junction for Hilcot & Upper Coberley. Sign has twisted and faces into
 field. Appears to require firmer fixing as occasional attempts to reposition sign
 fail as it twists back again. ACTION: GCC to secure sign please
